Optional – Optional but highly recommended

#### A

- **Acetaminophen (Tylenol)**
- **IV Acetaminophen – Optional**
- **Activase / t-PA (Alteplase)**
- **Adenosine (Adenocard)**
- **Afrin Nasal Spray**
- **Albuterol (Proventil / Ventolin / DuoNeb)**
- **Amiodarone (Cordarone)**
- **Aspirin**
- **Ativan / Lorazepam - Optional**
- **Atropine Sulfate**

#### C

- **Calcium Chloride**
- **Calcium Gluconate**
- **Ceftriaxone (Rocephin)** or Cefepime (Maxipine)
  - **Minimum 1 antibiotic on trucks**
- **Compazine**

#### D

- **Decadron (Dexamethasone)**
- **Dextrose (D10 / D25 / D50)**

- Some form of Dextrose for IV/IO

- Diazepam (Valium)
- Dilaudid
- **Diltiazem (Cardizem)**
- **Diphenhydramine (Benadryl)**
- Dopamine

## E

- **Epinephrine (1:1,000 / 1:10,000 / Racemic / Infusions)** \* *Indications:* Cardiac Arrest (Adult/Pediatric/Neonatal), Anaphylaxis, Severe Asthma, Croup (Racemic), and Vasopressor Infusions for Refractory Shock.
- Esmolol (Brevibloc) \**Indications:* Consider for refractory VF/VT **after the 2nd shock**. [Optional but highly recommended !!](#)
- **Etomidate (Amidate)** \* *Indications:* Induction agent for Drug-Assisted Airway / Rapid Sequence Intubation (RSI).

## F

- **Fentanyl (Sublimaze)**
- Furosemide (Lasix)
  - If transport time >30 min

## G

- **Glucagon**
- Geodon

## H

- **Haloperidol (Haldol)**
- Hydroxocobalamin (Cyanokit)
- **Heparin**

## I

- **Ibuprofen (Motrin / Advil)**
- **Ipratropium Bromide (Atrovent)**

## K

- **Ketamine (Ketalar)**
- **Ketorolac (Toradol)**
- **Keppra**

## L

- **Lidocaine -- Optional**
- **Labetalol**
- **Lorazepam - Optional**

## M

- **Magnesium Sulfate**
- **Metoprolol - Optional**
- **Midazolam (Versed)**
- **Morphine Sulfate** – May Substitute Fentanyl or Dilaudid – Must have One Narc

## N

- **Naloxone (Narcan)**
- **Nerve Agent Kit (Mark I / DuoDote)**
- **Nitroglycerin (NTG)**
  - Nitro Drip optional for short transport times/proximity to hospital
  - Nitro Push – **Optional but highly recommended**

- Nitrous Oxide
- Norepinephrine (Levophed)

## O

- Ondansetron (Zofran)
- Oxygen
- Oxytocin (Pitocin)

## P

- Pepcid (Famotidine) - May consider optional if agency doesn't have refrigerator
- Pralidoxime Chloride (2-PAM)

## R

- Rocuronium (Rocuroium)

## S

- Sodium Bicarbonate
- Sodium Thiosulfate
- Succinylcholine (Anectine)

## T

- Tranexamic Acid (TXA)
- Terbutaline

## V

- Vecuronium

## Z

- Zosyn (Must have one IV Antibiotic)

## IV/IO Fluids, Blood, & Oral Solutions

- Normal Saline (NS)

- **3% Hypertonic Saline**
- **Lactated Ringer's (LR)**
- **Whole Blood / Packed Red Blood Cells (PRBCs) / Fresh Frozen Plasma (FFP)**
- **Oral Glucose Paste/Solution**

Must Have at least one antibiotic

Must have at least one Narcotic Pain Medicine – Fentanyl, Morphine, Dilaudid

Must have Etomidate, Ketamine, Sux, Roc for DAI / RSI – Vecuronium is optional
